Tuesday, March 17 – In **Thailand**, FEBC is heard on 31 local and community radio stations across the country. Programs are also heard through Facebook Live, phone apps, and other social media platforms. There are currently 28,812 active Bible correspondence students studying God's Word. Pray for our Thai team to serve with love and energy.

Wednesday, March 18 – FEBC Indonesia hosts Radio Pars, the only Farsi-language program in Indonesia, which reaches 2,000+ Iranian refugees living in the Jakarta area. Programmers are volunteers and Iranian refugees themselves, who want to see the Gospel reach the hearts of their fellow refugees. Please pray for hearts to be open.

Thursday, March 19 – With a religious history that includes animism, folk Islam and Russian Orthodoxy, pray for God to draw the people of **Kazakhstan** to Himself. FEBC is currently heard through Internet-based broadcasts. Pray for our staff in this culturally Muslim nation. And pray for listeners to hear and respond to the truth of Jesus.

Friday, March 20 – Our team in **Mongolia** considers their work to be a partnership with local churches, who provide follow-up to our broadcasts. Pray that Mongolian churches will serve as centers of fellowship and discipleship.

Saturday, March 21 – Vasily, a former soldier wounded in the Ukraine/Russia conflict, became a Christian and now leads a small group in his church. "I saw how your programs changed hearts, pulling people out of alcoholism and desperation and bringing them into the light of Christ." Pray for many more to tune into our Ukraine broadcasts.

Sunday, March 22 – Even though Communism left a spiritual vacuum in **Moldova**, most Moldovans speak Russian. And now that FEBC's Russian-language broadcasts are heard on 7 Moldovan stations, people are able to hear the

Gospel. Please pray that listeners will respond to the Good News, which has been missing from this country for decades.

Monday, March 23 – FEBC currently reaches less than half the population of Cambodia. We have plans to add 4 additional relay stations that will increase our coverage. Please pray that funding and licensing will become available.

Tuesday, March 24 – In **Kyrgyzstan**, 75% of the population consider themselves Muslims; strict religious laws make it difficult for Christians to live out their faith. Please pray that FEBC's broadcasts are a source of light and encouragement to believers...and that non-believers will tune in and respond to the Good News.

Saturday, March 28 – Pray for listeners in the **Middle East** who are attracted to God's love but fear persecution. Pray for believers who can disciple them.

Sunday, March 29 – India has over 460 million Internet users. Pray for our India team, as they create online content to reach the country's youth.

Monday, March 30 – "Your teaching of God's Word touches our hearts in a special way, and your Bible stories give us great encouragement," writes a listener from **Vietnam**. Pray for changed lives in this Communist country.

Tuesday, March 31 – Please pray for FEBC International's new director in **Zimbabwe**, Melusi. Pray that God will give him wisdom to carry out all the plans he has for the station and remain steadfast.

Sunday, March 1 – FEBC's broadcasters are often seen as friends by our listeners, who tune in regularly to hear encouraging words and biblical truths to navigate the challenges of life. A listener from **India** shared: "*I am a widow with small children, and I feel lonely and depressed at times. Listening to your program gives me peace.*" Praise God for the peace He provides all of us when we turn to Him.

Monday, March 2 – Please pray for FEBC's *Radio Wimbe* team in Mozambique. They combine Bible teaching radio programs with face-to-face Bible study groups, to help bring lasting change to listeners. "Because of the Word of God heard on the radio, people are changing in many ways," a listener shared.

Tuesday, March 3 – Please pray for listeners in **North Korea**, who can hear FEBC's AM radio stations from South Korea. Pray for receptive hearts and lives to be changed. Pray also for North Korean Christians who desperately need encouragement to sustain their faith under a regime that forbids worship of anyone but their leader.

Wednesday, March 4 – Pray for FEBC's M.O.R.E. Project in Indonesia, where the radio ministry is partnering with 100+ privately owned radio stations. Pray that the Good News will be heard far and wide in this Muslimdominant country and that lives will be transformed.

Thursday, March 5 – Pray for the funding of more portable radios. FEBC distributes thousands every year to people unable to purchase their own. A listener in **Malawi** shared: "Without a radio, I would not have accepted Jesus as my Savior...and would not have joined a church." Radio has the ability to reach people on a daily basis with the Gospel, where they can come to understand God's amazing grace.

Friday, March 6 – FEBC not only shares the Good News through radio, but also through Gospel Speaker Boxes, Internet-based broadcasts, social media,

smartphone apps, satellite broadcasts, and other technological advances that allow the ministry to reach a potential listening audience of 4 billion people. Praise God for these many resources!

Saturday, March 7 – Please pray for God's protection for listeners to FEBC's broadcasts in China, especially students who are enrolled in the ministry's online Liangyou Theological Seminary. Pray that God will provide seminary teachers with wisdom and insight during this challenging time of strict religious restrictions in the country.

Thursday, March 12 – A listener in Africa writes: "Your programs are very helpful for our family. My father who is 75 years old received Jesus Christ after listening to you for two years." A transformed life in Christ is the best news ever!

Friday, March 13 – The radio ministry in Japan invests much time and patience in follow-up with inquiring listeners. Correspondence between staff and listeners may continue for years before a listener finally comes to faith in Christ. It is with such dedication and commitment that FEBC's Japanese ministry has continued for over 67 years. Please pray for a bountiful harvest one day.

Saturday, March 14 – A listener in the Philippines shared: "One day, while listening to your radio broadcast, I was introduced to Jesus.
