Wednesday, August 19 – God has given FEBC the opportunity to broadcast in 5 ethnic languages to the people of Myanmar. Pray for the protection and endurance of Christians in this southeast Asian nation. There is an immense pressure to be Buddhist, and the practice of Christianity is restricted by the military.

Thursday, August 20 – A listener in **Yemen** first heard about Jesus through FEBC broadcasts. He shares: "*I felt something change in me as I listened, something like hope.*" Please pray for this listener to continue to grow in his relationship with Christ.

Friday, August 21 – FEBC broadcasts are available 24/7 in **Kyrgyzstan**. Pray that these programs will bless listeners and bring change to the lives of those who do not yet know Jesus as their Savior.

Saturday, August 22 – A listener from Russia shared, "I was unsure of myself and always struggled with the meaning of life and who I am...then one day I found your broadcasts. Friday, August 28 – Pray for the **Hmong** ethnic group who reside in several countries in Southeast Asia. Many Hmong practice animism, a religion that worships spirits. Pray that they will hear the saving message of Jesus Christ and commit their lives to Him. **Saturday, August 29 –** Pray for FEBC leadership around the globe to have wisdom and discernment, as they make decisions in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic that continues to cause worldwide chaos. Pray that the Spirit of Peace will be upon the leadership of FEBC.
