

**Thursday, August 19 – Thailand** is predominantly Buddhist, yet FEBC has helped many in this country of 66 million develop a personal relationship with Jesus. A listener shared, *“This Bible program is my greatest friend and every truth in life. The Word of God is a balm that has almost fully healed the wounds in my heart. Now, I do not have any more suicidal thoughts because I know that God still loves me and is on my side.”* Praise God for the impact that hearing the Word has had on this listener’s life!

**Friday, August 20** – In sensitive areas of **Northeast Africa** intense violence can cause threats to the infrastructure of FEBC partnerships. Internet and mobile phone networks can be compromised, which directly affects listeners’ access to FEBC content and their only access to God’s Word. Please pray for safety in these regions.

**Saturday, August 21** – In **Myanmar**, there is immense social pressure to conform to Buddhism; the practice of Christianity is greatly restricted. In addition to the national language of Burmese, FEBC offers programs in 5 ethnic languages. Please pray that listeners will choose to give their lives to Christ and grow in their faith.

**Sunday, August 22** – A listener in **Mozambique** writes: *“I am one of your listeners; many of us gather together and listen to your programs. I just want to say how great the Way of Life program is and how it influences many lives here. Many have been blessed by your teachings and would love to learn more.* Praise God for hearts that yearn to learn more about God!

**Monday-, August 23** – Please pray for the spiritual and physical protection of churches around the world. FEBC aims to expose people to the Gospel through radio programs, but our prayer is that new believers will grow in their faith through community and discipleship at local churches.

**Tuesday, August 24** – FEBC uses many media platforms to reach people around the world. Please pray for listeners in the **Philippines** who have the opportunity to attend webinars to learn more about a relationship with Jesus.

**Wednesday, August 25** – In the northeastern region of **Mozambique**, the religions that people follow are either Islam or animism. Please pray for our Gospel broadcasts to reach these people and help them to have a change of heart that leads them to God’s love.

**Thursday, August 26** – A listener in **Cambodia** shared: *“Your child safety program touched my heart as a mother to learn how to protect and love my children. Thank you for encouraging me to be a good mother and bring hope to my children.”* We’re grateful for the many listeners who tune in to learn good parenting and relationship skills. As they listen, they also hear messages from the Bible. By so doing, many come to faith. Pray that many more will find Jesus through media.

**Friday, August 27** – In **Mali**, Gospel content is produced in 7 languages. Praise God for the opportunity to reach many people in this country and ask that He will provide continued protection for FEBC’s staff as they develop more programs.

**Saturday, August 28** – Please pray for women in **India**. As a marginalized gender, they often face discrimination, violence, and abuse. Pray that through Gospel-based programs, social media, and follow-up ministry, the Lord will work in these women’s lives to bring healing and encouragement.

**Sunday, August 29** – Data speaks loudly; the following numbers attest to God using your gifts to change lives through radio and other technology: last year alone, we received over 148 million listener engagements and responses to the Gospel. Praise God for these numbers, because numbers represent people. Pray that many will come to faith in the Lord!

**Monday-, August 30** – In **Laos**, the Gospel is becoming more available through social media. For example, FEBC’s Hmong Radio program is currently accessible through Facebook and YouTube. Praise God for these opportunities for listeners to encounter the Gospel; pray that hearts will be changed as a result of hearing the truth.

**Tuesday, August 31** – Please pray for our team in **Taiwan**, who assist in the daily production of Mandarin programming, along with FEBC teams in **Hong Kong, Canada** and the **U.S.** Please pray for the Lord to inspire staff as they work together to produce 23.75 hours of Mandarin broadcasts every day.

**Sunday, August 1** – Many times testimonies from listeners reveal the impact of God’s Word on their lives. A listener from **China** told us: *“By listening to Gospel radio for 3 years, I’ve come to know that Christianity is not superstitious but a true belief. That’s why I made the decision to come to Christ.”* Praise God for this changed life!

**Monday, August 2** – We’re encouraged by listener responses from **Laos**, who can access our ethnic language broadcasts. Additionally, house churches are growing and many listeners are coming to faith, despite an authoritarian government that monitors its people closely and frowns on Christianity. Please pray that many will hear the Good News and respond.

**Tuesday, August 3** – Praise God for the work He is doing in eastern **Ukraine!** A telephone hotline was developed to help people in distress during the pandemic. FEBC staff handled 1,500 calls every month, listening, praying and helping people in need get connected to local churches. Pray that many will come to know Jesus and trust in Him.

**Wednesday, August 4** – Please pray for believers in **Yemen** who are disowned by their family members and friends when they discover they have turned to Christ. Pray that they will find comfort in their relationship with Jesus and grow in their faith through FEBC International radio programs.

**Thursday, August 5** – Please pray for ethnic programmers in the **Philippines** as they produce Gospel broadcasts in various languages and dialects. Reaching people in their native language is essential to changing a person’s heart.

**Friday, August 6** – In **Pakistan**, Christians struggle with persecution on a daily basis. Please ask God to guide FEBC’s efforts here; we are committed to reaching the people in this heavily Muslim country as well as encouraging believers.

**Saturday, August 7** – Earlier this year, FEBC International’s newest station in **Chad** was a target of arson three times. Please pray for our efforts in this north-central African country despite the many challenges, particularly ongoing political instability.

**Sunday, August 8** – Pray that our broadcasts into **North Korea** will continue to reach more listeners in this tightly controlled country. Pray that the Holy Spirit will open the hearts of listeners.

**Monday-, August 9** – **Indonesia** may have the largest Muslim population in the world, but God is using FEBC to share the Gospel on 7 stations and in 7 languages. We are also partnering with 98 local stations who have added our programs to their daily schedules. Please pray that many will hear and respond to God’s amazing grace.

**Tuesday, August 10** – Pray that the Lord will provide funds for FEBC to continue His work around the world. In hardest to reach areas where people can barely put food on the table, we are committed to providing radios so people can tune into our programs. This is often the only way they will ever learn about Jesus.

**Wednesday, August 11** – In **Mongolia**, broadcasts are aired in the Mongolian language 24 hours daily through 13 FM radio stations. Please pray for the hearts of listeners who will discover FEBC broadcasts.

**Thursday, August 12** – Please pray for FM broadcasts produced and aired for the Yao people, a primarily Muslim group who reside in several countries throughout Africa, with a large population in **Malawi**. Pray that the Lord will use these programs to inspire listeners to turn from Islam to Jesus.

**Friday, August 13** – Praise God for the opportunities He gives us to strategically reach countries that do not allow religious broadcasting to originate within their country, such as in **Japan**. When our team wraps up production, they send it to our office in **South Korea**, where it is transmitted back into Japan. Please pray for continued collaboration between FEBC’s various teams.

**Saturday, August 14** – In addition to Vietnamese, FEBC currently offers broadcasts in 20 minority languages in **Vietnam**. Please pray for opportunities to reach even more languages: there are a total of 54 ethnic languages in this Southeast Asian country.

**Sunday, August 15** – Pray that our team in **Kyrgyzstan** will be effective in their use of social media to reach younger audiences. Please also pray that our team will be effective in their efforts to reach new listeners through our radio broadcasts.

**Monday-, August 16** – There are approximately 20 million Muslims in **Russia** today. Pray that FEBC’s robust social media platforms, online broadcasts and radio broadcasts will reach many and guide them into a relationship with Jesus.

**Tuesday, August 17** – Sometimes, listeners share that simply hearing the Good News in their native language is enough to soften their hearts to the Gospel. A listener from the **Middle East** shared, *“It is unbelievable to hear real voices that talk about spiritual things in our language.”* Please pray for this listener as they discover who Jesus is through these broadcasts.

**Wednesday, August 18** – One of FEBC’s newest radio station partnerships is in Osh, Kyrgyzstan, which is the sixth station to join an FM network in the country. Because of the Lord’s guidance, two thirds of the country’s population is now able to access Gospel-based content 24/7. Please pray for the hearts of listeners!
