UNREACHED PRAYER FOCUS:

THE TATAR

The Tatars of Russia number around five million people and live primarily around the Volga river in Russia. Many Tatars have both Mongolian and Russian physical features since they are a result of the Monglian horde’s historical expansion into Russia.

The Tatars are a very well-educated people, appreciate the arts, and hold a wide range of jobs. This includes everything from traditional farming and herding, to manufacturing, as well as jobs in the theater.

Around 90% of Tatars in Russia are Muslim, but many are more liberal with moderate beliefs. **Less than 1% of Tatars in Russia are known to be Evangelical Christians.** The Russian Tatars are hesitant to follow Christianity, because historically they have been oppressed by the Russian Orthodox church, which burned mosques and tried to force Tatars to convert. The Bible was only fully translated into the Tatar language in the last few years, and few Evangelical churches exist in Russia.



PRAY FOR THE TATAR

☐ **Monday, July 1**

Today, pray for the unreached Tatar. Ask God to open their hearts to the Gospel, in spite of historical hesitancy, and for the Tatar to discover the Bible and read it for the first time. May God use FEBC Russia’s team to build relationships with the Tatar as they share Gospel broadcasts.



☐ **Tuesday, July 2**

Pray for the unreached people living in **Malawi**. The country has experienced severe power outages lasting up to 12 hours at a time. Pray for FEBC’s local team as they install solar energy solutions to allow broadcasting to continue uninterrupted.

☐ **Wednesday, July 3**

Please pray for listeners like Arsenie, from **Russia**, who struggled with drug addiction. *“I went to a Christian rehab center—that saved my life. I became a Christian there, and that’s where I started listening to FEBC’s programs. You helped me so much. Thank you!”* Please pray for the many listeners dealing with drug addiction. FEBC Russia partners with many Christian rehab centers, providing them with Gospel broadcasts for the patients to listen to.

☐ **Thursday, July 4**

Today we celebrate Independence Day. Thank God for the freedom we have in our country to worship Him freely. Pray for those all over the world who are unable to worship Christ openly, especially those who are persecuted for their Christian beliefs.

☐ **Friday, July 5**

Please pray for the unreached people of **China** and **Hong Kong**. Many continue to face daily challenges due to the high unemployment rate. May God bring hope to the hearts of the people living there and guide our staff as they continue to share the Good News.

☐ **Saturday, July 6**

Pray for those living in **Mongolia** who are facing economic challenges due to the ongoing war in Ukraine. Also, ask the Lord to guide FEBC’s rural teams as they speak with listeners and share the message of hope.

☐ **Sunday, July 7**

Praise God for changing lives in **Pakistan!** A listener recently said: *“What I have learned (from FEBC) has motivated me to share the truth about the Christian faith with others.”* Please pray that more hearts will be open to receive and share the truth of the Gospel in Pakistan.

☐ **Monday, July 8**

FEBC partners with local churches whenever possible. While our broadcasters are gifted at sharing the Gospel, we believe churches are best designed to offer discipleship and fellowship to new believers. Pray our partnerships will be strengthened to help people of all ages grow in their faith.

☐ **Tuesday, July 9**

Thank God for the increase in listeners on FEBC **Cambodia’s** social media channels. Pray that the hearts of these new listeners will be open to the Good News and accept Jesus as their Savior.

☐ **Wednesday, July 10**

Pray for broadcasts being heard in **Moldova** today. Thank God for each listener there and ask for His truth to take root in their hearts.

☐ **Thursday, July 11**

Please pray for people living in **Indonesia**—the most populous Muslim nation in the world. FEBC has shared the Good News to listeners there for over 50 years. Ask the Lord to guide and direct our team so that more people hear and experience the power of God’s Word and come to faith.

☐ **Friday, July 12**

FEBC’s Gospel Speaker Boxes are an effective tool to reach ethnic groups in **Southeast Asia**. The devices include SD cards with over 130 hours of Gospel programming on each card, allowing listeners to hear broadcasts at any time. Pray that all who listen will be changed by the power of the Gospel.

☐ **Saturday, July 13**

Over 900 people faithfully serve on FEBC’s staff in countries across the globe. Broadcasters, counselors, engineers, programmers, and directors are just a few examples of the many roles needed to lead the ministry. Pray for our teams as they work to share Jesus with the unreached around the world.

☐ **Sunday, July 14**

Please pray for the people of **India**. May the Lord extend FEBC’s footprint and increase our Gospel broadcasts to transform lives in this very difficult area. Pray also for our local team to have freedom to serve the ministry each day, with courage to stand strong.

☐ **Monday, July 15**

Please pray for the people of **Myanmar**. Despite this country’s vast resources, it’s considered to be one of the world’s poorest places. Pray for the Paluang people living in refugee camps. Many are persecuted because of their faith in Jesus. Ask the Lord to provide for those in need and guide FEBC’s key leaders as they broadcast the Gospel to reach this nation of 55 million.

☐ **Tuesday, July 16**

Praise God! FEBC **Ukraine** has received a 10-year license to broadcast in the cities of Kyiv and Ivano-Frankivsk, where we had temporary war-time licenses. These two stations are receiving the majority of FEBC Ukraine’s listener responses, especially in Kyiv, the capital. Please pray for the people in this region to hear about the hope of Christ through FEBC’s programs.

☐ **Wednesday, July 17**

Pray for those living in the **Philippines**, especially those still recovering from Super Typhoon Karding. All our staff and broadcast facilities were spared from major harm and damage. May the Good News continue to reach the hearts of all who are searching in this country.
