☐ Sunday, June 29


Please pray for **Belarus**, a country suffering from political and economic crises. Pray for listeners who can experience the message of the Gospel through FEBC programs on social media.

UNREACHED PRAYER FOCUS:

BAMBARA

The Bambara are a people group of around 9 million people, living mainly in Mali and other west African countries. They are primarily farmers. Men and women farm the fields together, though women spend less time in the fields so they can prepare meals for the family.

Families within Bambara villages are communal. They work together to provide food and other necessities for one another. Homes are larger than most others in Africa, some housing up to 60 people.

Only 1% of Bambara are estimated to be Christians. While Islam is the official religion of the Bambara people, many still worship their ancestors and participate in other spirit worship.
