UNREACHED PRAYER FOCUS:

SHAN

The Shan people, one of the largest ethnic groups in Myanmar, are also found in parts of Thailand and China. With a population of approximately 4.6 million, the Shan have a rich cultural heritage and speak a language related to Thai and Lao.

Agriculture is at the heart of Shan life. Families live in villages ranging from a handful, to several hundred households, typically located along rivers and roadways. Their main livelihood comes from farming, with rice being the staple crop.

In Myanmar, the Shan have long sought greater autonomy. They maintain their own ethnic armed forces, which have resisted the control of the Burmese military regime. For decades, this ongoing conflict has strained communities and caused deep divisions within families.

The vast majority of Shan people follow Buddhism, and only about 0.9% identify as Christian, making them one of the least-reached people groups. With limited access to Christian resources or outreach, many have yet to hear the message of hope and peace found in Christ.

Pray for Alexandr and Nadia, broadcasters and evangelistic counselors with FEBC **Ukraine**. Ask for God to help them endure the conflict and have emotional strength as they serve others through housing refugees. May the Lord also keep their families safe.

Praise God for the launch of two new ethnic broadcasts in **India.** We're told that there's a large listenership to these programs. Pray that it will reach the hearts of many. Also pray for staff and volunteers managing their helpline to meet the needs of people calling in for encouragement and support.
