UNREACHED PRAYER FOCUS:

THE RAKHINE

The Rakhine are an unreached people group of around 2.7 million people living mainly in western Myanmar (Southeast Asia). Most follow Buddhism, and their region is filled with temples. Fewer than a few hundred Rakhine are believed to be Christians.

The Rakhine speak a Burmese dialect, and most families depend on farming or fishing, as they have for generations. Known for their generosity and resilience, the Rakhine remain resistant to the Gospel. The first Portuguese monks arrived in the 1600s to share about Jesus, and many missionaries have followed, yet only limited fruit has been seen. Today, the small number of Rakhine believers are spread across different denominations, making it difficult for churches to unite in their efforts.

Just recently the Bible was translated into the Rakhine language. FEBC also began broadcasting in the region a couple years ago. Now, the Rakhine can hear the Gospel in their heart language over the airwaves, and in the written word.

Please pray for the people of **Vietnam.** The local church and evangelism efforts are still suffering in the aftermath of the pandemic. Pray for FEBC broadcasts to reach the unreached with the Gospel to restore their lives with God's plan and purpose.

Thank God for opportunities for youth in **Kazakhstan** to share the Gospel through social media. Our team is receiving strong response from viewers who are interested in faith and church. Pray that many will come to Christ in this traditionally Muslim country and share the Gospel with others.

☐ Sunday, December 7

Pray today for FEBC ministry directors and staff all over the world. These leaders face challenges every day to reach the unreached. May the Lord provide wisdom, clarity, protection, and endurance as they serve and lead their teams.

☐ Monday, December 8

Praise God! Our team has made progress with meeting listeners in **India** and distributing Speaker Boxes. May our Gospel programs bless each listener and help make new disciples of Jesus in this Hindu majority nation.

\square Tuesday, December 9

Please pray for the growing ministry in the Buryat Republic in **Russia**, near Mongolia. Locals there practice a mixture of Buddhism, Animism, and ancestral worship. Our team is receiving encouraging testimonies and producing short videos with pastors from the area. The videos have been viewed several million times—praise God!

Today, pray for the weekly evangelistic meeting for women led by Inna, a broadcaster for FEBC in **Ukraine**. "We talk about the Lord, we pray, and we read the Bible.
