□ Monday, January 19


Pray for those living in **Mongolia** who are facing economic challenges due to the ongoing war in Ukraine. Also, ask the Lord to guide FEBC's rural teams as they speak with listeners and share the message of hope.

□ Tuesday, January 20

Please pray for listeners like Alyona, from **Russia**, who was taking care of a child with special needs. *"Thank you so much for your program. I sometimes get very tired, and there is no one I can talk to. Thank you for listening to me and responding. Thank you for your prayers! Your programs are such a great resource for me. I've learned so much about my relationships with my children."* Please pray for FEBC Russia's family programs which are addressing a great need in Russian society.

□ Wednesday, January 21

Please pray for the unreached people of **Kyrgyzstan** and also for our team as they minister in this traditionally Islamic country. The number of schools offering Islamic religious education have increased greatly. May the Lord use our team to reach young people with the light of the Gospel.



□ Friday, January 23

Pray for broadcasts being heard in **Moldova**. Also, pray for our Teen Project, which creates programs for teenagers and invites them to in-person meetings to learn more about Christ and the Bible, pray together, and get to know our local broadcasters in Moldova. Pray for hearts to be open to the Gospel as they build strong relationships in these gatherings.

□ Saturday, January 24

Today, pray for Joshua and Nit C. who serve FEBC in **Thailand**. Pray for guidance as they build relationships with listeners, develop programs for 17 ethnic languages, and manage the details of the growing Khmu ministry.

□ Sunday, January 25

FEBC's Gospel Speaker Boxes are an effective tool to reach ethnic groups in **Southeast Asia**. The devices include SD cards with over 130 hours of Gospel programming on each card, allowing listeners to hear broadcasts at any time. Pray that all who listen will be changed by the power of the Gospel.

□ Monday, January 26

Praise God for changing lives in **Mongolia**! A listener recently said: *"I heard the Good News on the radio for the first time. My understanding (of Jesus) is growing and I'm so thankful!"* Please pray that more hearts will be open to receive the truth of the Gospel in Mongolia.

□ Tuesday, January 27

Please pray for Jurie, the director of our **South Africa** ministry. He and his team lead efforts in Mozambique, Malawi, Mali, and Chad. Pray also for the broadcasters as they prepare daily and weekly Gospel programs.

□ Wednesday, January 28

Over 900 people faithfully serve on FEBC's staff in countries across the globe. Broadcasters, counselors, engineers, programmers, and directors are just a few examples of the many roles needed to lead the ministry. Pray for our teams as they work to share Jesus with the unreached around the world.

□ Thursday, January 29

A listener in **Cambodia** shared: *"The radio broadcasts have filled me with hope! I have learned to forgive and embrace the value of living in love. □ Friday, January 30

UNREACHED PRAYER FOCUS:

THE UNREACHED

In global missions, “unreached” describes people groups with little to no access to the Gospel. Many of them live within the “10/40 Window”—a region stretching from North Africa across the Middle East to Asia. This area is often called “The Resistance Belt,” as it includes the majority of the world’s Muslims, Hindus, and Buddhists, who are among the hardest to reach.

Out of the world’s population of over 8 billion, about 3.4 billion people remain unreached—around 42% of all people. Most of them do not have a Bible in their own language, a local church, or even personal contact with a Christian. Without outside help, they are unlikely to ever hear about Jesus.

The barriers are many: cultural differences, language gaps, geographic isolation, oppressive governments, and restrictive religious systems. But one of the greatest challenges is financial—most of the money in churches’ budgets go to already-reached groups, and a very small percentage is directed toward reaching the unreached.

□ Thursday, January 1

Even though **Japan**’s population is less than 1% Christian, God is moving among the people there. We’re grateful to receive letters like this: *“It’s been 5 years since I discovered FEBC broadcasting. Not a day goes by that I don’t listen to it. I can endure even the toughest days because I believe that God loves me and is with me!”*

□ Monday, January 5

Please pray for people living in **Indonesia**—the most populous Muslim nation in the world. FEBC has shared the Good News to listeners there for over 50 years. Ask the Lord to guide and direct our team so that more people hear and experience the power of God’s Word and come to faith.

□ Tuesday, January 6

FEBC launched a project to reach Muslim listeners living in **Russia**, **Kazakhstan**, and **Kyrgyzstan**. Former Muslims, who are now Christians, are sharing their testimonies on the air. Please pray for the safety of these brave new Christians, as they often face threats and are persecuted for their faith.

□ Wednesday, January 7

Thank God for the increase in listeners on FEBC **Cambodia**’s social media channels. Pray that the hearts of these new listeners will be open to the Good News and accept Jesus as their Savior.

□ Thursday, January 8

Pray for those living in the **Philippines**, and the 5.9 million who are still unreached. Ask the Lord to guide our staff as they broadcast the Gospel from 13 AM and FM stations strategically located in key cities all over the country.

□ Friday, January 9

In remote parts of **Central Asia**, there are people groups that have never heard the story of Jesus in their own language. Pray for new opportunities to share God’s love and the amazing gift of Salvation through Jesus Christ.

□ Saturday, January 10

Take a moment to thank God and praise Him for the millions of people all over the world who have tuned into FEBC today and heard the Good News. Thank the Lord for the seeds that have been planted, and for those who have accepted Jesus Christ as their Savior! May the Gospel continue to be proclaimed... until all have heard.

□ Sunday, January 11

Please pray for the people of **Myanmar**. Despite this country’s vast resources, it’s considered to be one of the world’s poorest places. Pray for the Paluang people living in refugee camps. Many are persecuted because of their faith in Jesus. Ask the Lord to provide for those in need and guide FEBC’s key leaders as they broadcast the Gospel to reach this nation of 55 million.

□ Monday, January 12

Pray for FEBC **Ukraine** as they continue to broadcast in the cities of Kyiv and Ivano-Frankivsk. These two stations are receiving the majority of FEBC Ukraine’s listener responses, especially in Kyiv, the capital. Please pray for the people in this region to hear about the hope of Christ through FEBC’s programs.

□ Tuesday, January 13

Please pray for the people of **India**. May the Lord extend FEBC’s footprint and increase our Gospel broadcasts to transform lives in this very difficult area. Pray also for our local team to have freedom to serve the ministry each day, with courage to stand strong.

□ Wednesday, January 14

A member of a listener club in **Malawi** shared: *“I would like to thank God for the listener club in my village. I have received Jesus Christ as my Lord!”* Pray for FEBC’s local team as they broadcast the Gospel into many remote areas and follow-up with listeners who are discovering Jesus.

Please pray for people in **Kazakhstan**. Recently, our local team has expanded to help support the growing outreach efforts to Muslim listeners both young and old. May the Lord continue to direct our team as they broadcast the Good News and build new relationships with listeners.
