UNREACHED PRAYER FOCUS:

THAI

Thailand means “Land of the Free”, yet the Thai people there remain captive to Buddhism, spirit worship, and even occult practices.¹ With a population of around 70 million people, 93% of the country’s population self-identify as Buddhists. Less than 1% claim to be Christian.² Prostitution is also a pressing social problem with thousands forced into this way of life to help their families survive.

“To be Thai is to be Buddhist” is a common phrase uttered in Thailand. Unfortunately, Thai culture views Christianity as a religion of the West. Becoming a Christian requires a fundamental shift in identity, one which often faces obstacles from family members and neighbors.

Despite these challenges, Thailand has become a hub for missions. Christians have made substantial contributions to healthcare and education in their communities. But sharing Jesus, offering discipleship, and growing local churches in a manner relevant for Thai culture is still a great need.

☐ **Sunday, February 1**

Pray for millions of people living in **Thailand** who do not know about the saving love of Jesus. Despise the Buddhist-dominate culture, may the Lord raise up more Thai Christian leaders who will have a heart for evangelism, discipleship, and growing the church.



☐ **Monday, February 2**

The island nation of **Japan** is home to over 125 million people and only 0.5% of them are Christian. Pray for people to discover lasting truth and hope found in the Gospel, especially the Japanese youth who often struggle with depression and self-esteem.

☐ **Tuesday, February 3**

Please pray for listeners like Turar, from **Kazakhstan**, who discovered the Gospel through FEBC Kazakhstan’s social media programs. *“I used to be a devoted Muslim.... but after a while, I realized there was no truth there. So, I turned away from Islam. Now I am looking for the true path.”* Turar is speaking regularly with FEBC’s broadcasters about Jesus and Christianity. Please pray for him to see the truth of the Gospel and to place his faith in Christ.

☐ **Wednesday, February 4**

Despite economic and political turmoil in **Belarus**, God is expanding FEBC’s ministry there. Our programs are reaching larger, younger audiences through social media. Pray for many to hear and accept the Gospel and feel His presence in their lives.

☐ **Thursday, February 5**

Pray for the unreached people in **Cambodia**. Also, pray for our local programmers who regularly meet with listeners face-to-face. May the Cambodian people discover the one, true God and accept Jesus as their Savior.

☐ **Friday, February 6**

Please pray for those living in **Kyrgyzstan**. The war in Ukraine has impacted this country on several economic and political levels. Ask the Lord to guide our team as they broadcast the Good News and respond to the rapidly growing audience of social media listeners.

☐ **Saturday, February 7**

FEBC’s programs are reaching listeners in **India**, where 95% of the population is unreached. Pray that our ministry will continue to effectively share the life-changing message of Jesus with listeners far and wide.

☐ **Sunday, February 8**

“Thank you for being with me during the darkest time of my life,” said Karina, a teenage girl from **Ukraine**. Karina was in the hospital after a suicide attempt. *“I am in such a better place. Thank you for sharing God’s love with me. Now I know that He is always with me.”* Please pray for Karina and for other teens who are struggling with depression and hopelessness, to let the love of Christ surround and heal their hearts.

☐ **Monday, February 9**

Please pray for the people of **Myanmar**. The entire country is in chaos, and many are suffering. Thousands have left their cities and homes to escape military attacks. Pray for FEBC’s team to not grow weary in sharing the Good News so that many would come to know Jesus as their Savior.

☐ **Tuesday, February 10**

In the Buddhist-dominant country of **Thailand**, there are over 3,800 students participating in FEBC’s Bible Correspondence Course. Many of the participants are in prison and have come to faith through studying the Bible. Pray for these students to have open hearts and minds as they study the life of Jesus.

☐ **Wednesday, February 11**

Many Christians living in **Pakistan** feel isolated from society due to the dominance of Islam. When they listen to FEBC’s broadcasts, they experience encouragement and realize they are not alone. Pray for the Lord to provide more opportunities for Christian community and draw hearts closer to Christ.

☐ **Thursday, February 12**

Please pray for the unreached people of **Russia**. As the Russian government continues to increase restrictions on free speech, our team is continuing to spread the Good News, seeing countless lives transformed. Please pray for the FEBC Russia team as they find new ways to continue sharing the Gospel in these difficult times.

☐ **Friday, February 13**

Pray for the people of **South Korea**. A listener recently wrote: *“Hallelujah! Yesterday, through your broadcast, my mother accepted Christ as her Savior! I am very grateful to FEBC.”* May God bring many more stories of salvation to the Korean Peninsula.

☐ **Saturday, February 14**

Gospel broadcasts are reaching people in **Laos** through MP3 players, shortwave radio, and Facebook Live. Pray for God’s strength for believers who are persecuted and for more Lao people to come to believe and trust in God through Jesus Christ.

☐ **Sunday, February 15**

Pray for the ethnic people groups who do not have access to a Bible in their own language. These listeners often record FEBC’s programs to help them grow in their faith. May God’s Word come alive in their hearts and encourage them to share the love of Jesus with others.

☐ **Monday, February 16**

Praise God for blessing His Word through FEBC’s ministry in **Cambodia**. New listeners are hearing the Gospel from our broadcasters and accepting Jesus as their Savior!
